


The Boy Who Was Raised by Librarians

PASS Objectives:

Standard 5 Data Analysis - The student will demonstrate an understanding of data collection, display and interpretation.

- 1. Collect, sort, organize, and display data in charts, bar graphs, and tables.
- 2. Summarize and interpret data in charts, bar graphs, and tables.
- 3. Make predictions and estimates to describe data.

Supplies: Large chart paper, crayons/markers

Summary: In this story, librarians help Melvin organize his bug collection and his baseball card collection. Do you have a special collection? i.e. sticker, coin, pictures, etc.

Activity: Graph It!

- 1. Bring your special collection to class or find a collection of something in your classroom.
- 2. Sort/organize your collection according to established criteria.
- 3. Make a chart, graph, or table to show your findings. Use the large chart paper and crayons or markers to construct your project.
